


SPCA Serving Erie County Community Presentations For Adults

Presentation Topics

Designed to be a personal experience for your group, presentations offered are:

- **History of the Humane Movement** –examines the history of the SPCA.
- **Wildlife Warriors** –promotes respect and care for the earth and all animals while learning how to help preserve and protect wildlife.
- **Puppy Mills** –recognizes the basic needs of caring for dogs. Understand what a puppy mill is and recognize the deficits inherent in puppy mills while identifying legal actions and animal cruelty laws.
- **Animal Cruelty** –encourages kindness in the community. Learn about the state of dog fighting and how our community can help. Also, how to identify cruelty and understand the laws surrounding cruelty.
- **Cats in History** –take an engaging look at cats through a historical journey of our attitudes and responses to cats.
