Presentation Topics

Designed to be an interactive experience for your group, presentations offered are:

- **Animal Safety and Dog Bite Prevention** – Teaches children how to greet a dog, how to play safely with their pets, and what to do if a new animal approaches them.
- **Being a Responsible Pet Owner** –Allows children to learn about caring for their pets by helping them understand the importance of responsible pet ownership.
- **Critter Careers** –explores animal careers from veterinarians to trainers, there are many avenues for animal lovers to pursue.
- **Wildlife Warriors** –promotes respect and care for the earth and all animals while learning how to help preserve and protect wildlife.
- **Animal Cruelty** – encourages kindness in the community by teaching kids how to identify and report animal cruelty.
- **Puppy Mills** –recognizes the basic needs of caring for dogs. Understand what a puppy mill is while identifying legal actions and animal cruelty laws.

Presentations are designed to be personal and engaging. Topics available will depend on the age and development of the group.
